

Safeguarding Our School Children, \$6350

For nearly 70 years, Trinity Lutheran Church and School has provided schooling in an impoverished community in urban Mobile, Alabama to children most of whom are unchurched but who are now hearing of God's Word. This area's violence (murder, robbery, and burglary) is three times the national average. Although the school's security system exists, it requires improvement to enhance safety for the 195 children who are enrolled in its childcare development center, grade school and after school tutoring programs, for the 125 children who attend the ten-week summer enrichment program, and for the parents, staff, and teachers using the facility. This grant would help upgrade their security system to a level found in similarly sized elementary schools and childcare centers across the country.
