

Healing Spaces, \$6500

Since 1952, the Dakota Boys and Girls Ranch have been helping children 10-18 years old who face severe psychiatric, emotional, behavioral and/or developmental challenges due to abuse, neglect, violence and more. The Ranch in Minot, North Dakota, and its Kruse Memorial Chapel have a project titled, "Healing Spaces". This encompasses weekly chapel experiences offering healing care of the Gospel and the life-giving presence of Christ Jesus to these children in desperate need of His mercy and hope. The Kruse Memorial Chapel has not had major updates in two decades – the most in needful are the restrooms with outdated structures. These restrooms can be a negative influence on the children who are already trauma sensitive. This grant would assist in the total re-vamping of the restrooms.
