Therefore, I tell you, do not be anxious about your life, what you will eat or what you will drink, nor about your body, what you will put on..... Look at the birds of the air: they neither sow nor reap nor gather into barns. And yet your heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not of more value than they\* (Matthew 6: 25a, 26)?

For those at home, be assured: our Leadership is there, new plans are exciting, and our shoulders are the "stones of support and continued uplifting" of this body. We know how to do this! WITH THE BLESSING OF OUR HEAVENLY FATHER!

Individually and collectively, we have been set apart to do His will. In this role, it's our job to offer prayer, praise, and thanksgiving, and witness to others by our very acts of caring and sharing. At the Retreat, our in-gathering and bundling over 700 Blessing Bags for the Homeless was a profound witness and a labor of love for many. We will never know those lives we touch, but God promises his Grace is imperishable. And may the devotionals tucked inside sprout Hope to many and grow into the light of His purpose. *SO: as Luke reminds us in Acts 14:22....* May God strengthen the souls of the disciples, encouraging them to continue in the faith.
